The vibrant campus of Biswa Bangla Biswabidyalay offers a dynamic and inclusive environment where students can thrive.





Eligibility Criteria:

Masters in Sanskrit and Indology

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Sanskrit from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Linguistics and Endangered Languages

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Santali, Arabic or in any other Indian or foreign languages from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Education and Teachers' Training

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in **Education** from any UGC-recognized University.









Masters in Physical Education and Sports Science

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Physical Education from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Political Science and International Relations

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in **Political Science** from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Geography

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Geography from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Visual Arts (Painting)

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course in Visual Arts or Fine Arts from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Performative Arts (Music and Drama)

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course in Performative Arts such as Music, Drama, Instruments from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Commerce and Accounting

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Commerce from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Business Administration (Human Resource)

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course in any field from any UGC-recognized University. However, 50% seats will remain reserved for B.Com and BBA candidates.

Masters in Chemical Sciences (Chemistry)

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Chemistry or any allied branch of Chemistry from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Physiology and Human Anatomy

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Physiology or Human Anatomy from any UGC-recognized University.



Masters in Physical Science (Physics)

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Physics, Electronics or any allied branches of Physical Sciences from any UGC-recognized University.

Masters in Biological Sciences and Microbiology

Candidates having completed a three-year graduation course on 2022 or after with Hons. in Zoology, Botany or Microbiology from any UGC-recognized University.

Seats are reserved in accordance with the UGC/ Govt of WB regulations.
